Failure/ difficulty or in personal care skills (e.g., potty training, dressing Grooming, motor, cleaning, washing and feeding self). Failure/ difficulty in cognitive functioning, characterized by poor planning Thinking, reasoning, decision making and problem-solving skills. Difficulty in demonstrating behaviors appropriate to age, gender and Circumstances as per social pattern. Poor/ failure in school performance. Failure/ difficulty to adjust in different situations and demand of new environment. Failure/problems to understand and follow social rules Attention deficits and difficulty in remembering. Difficulty to connect behaviors with its consequences. Problem to express any desire.
